Municipal Enterprise "Kyiv Regional Center for Rehabilitation Medicine"

Kyiv Regional Hospital No. 2 (KRH No. 2) was established in 1991 on the basis of a special hospital of the Kyiv Regional Medical and Sanatorium Department to provide services to victims of the Chornobyl accident.

In June 2023, KRH No. 2 was reorganized into a municipal non-profit enterprise of the Kyiv Regional Council "KYIV REGIONAL CENTER FOR REHABILITATION MEDICINE".

The main building of the center is located in the Podil district of Kyiv in the Syretsky Grove. The buildings are located on a separate land plot of 5.2 hectares.

Advantages:


- Location in the "green" zone of Kyiv;

- Providing a wide range of comprehensive medical services to both military and civilians.


Challenges:

- Lack of modern equipment for rehabilitation, diagnostics, laboratory tests;
- Non-compliance with modern energy efficiency standards.

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Implementation of the Rehabilitation Center project requires:

- 1. Renovation of the main building of the rehabilitation center with modernization of engineering networks.
- 2. Equipping the diagnostic and laboratory center with modern equipment:
 - MRI
 - Biochemical analyzer
 - Automatic coagulator
 - Blood gas and electrolyte analyzer
 - Electrocardiographs
 - ENT combine
 - And more

- 3. Equipping the departments with modern medical equipment:
 - Physical rehabilitation
 - Verticalizers
 - Simulators
 - Rehabilitation of upper and lower limbs
 - Devices for restoring walking skills
 - Lifts
 - Robotic locomotive
 - And more

The Rehabilitation Center renovation project is under development.
A detailed work plan and equipment list are being worked out.



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






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







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Budget of renovation a rehabilitation medical center in Ukraine

Recommendations for expanding the functional content of a Rehabilitation center in Ukraine

Functions and tasks of the multifunctional rehabilitation center (VIDRODZHENNYA, Karnaukh M.I., ECC, Conger&Higgins):

- 1. Diagnosis of injuries, diseases and pathological conditions which require rehabilitation in future.
- 2. Provision of extensive inpatient rehabilitation care in expanded departments after long-term rehabilitation in conditions of round-the-clock stay or stay in a day hospital.
- 3. Provision of rehabilitation assistance on an outpatient basis (outpatient consultations and rehabilitation of patients).
- 4. Provision of home rehabilitation (rehabilitation assistance provided at the place of residence (stay) of a person who needs rehabilitation, during post-acute and long-term rehabilitation periods outside the center).
- 5. Provision of periodic supportive rehabilitation assistance (rehabilitation assistance that can be provided during a long term rehabilitation period with the aim of preventing loss, slowing loss, improving or maintaining the functioning of a person who needs rehabilitation)
- 6. The possibility of providing rehabilitation assistance in a mobile mode (the work model of a multidisciplinary rehabilitation team or individual rehabilitation specialists of inpatient or outpatient departments of post-acute and long-term rehabilitation, which consists in providing rehabilitation care during the acute rehabilitation period at the patient's place of residence (stay) in non-rehabilitation departments of health care facilities or in other health care facilities, in educational institutions in the field of health care, in special institutions of general secondary education, which do not have rehabilitation departments, subdivisions)
- 7. Provision of rehabilitation in the territorial community (a strategy within the framework of the overall development of territorial communities regarding rehabilitation, equalization of opportunities and social integration of all persons in need of rehabilitation, which is ensured by the joint efforts of the persons in need of rehabilitation, their families, organizations, local executive bodies and local self-government bodies in spheres of health care, education, social protection, etc)
- 8. Provision of rehabilitation care using telerehabilitation, through telerehabilitation consultation and examination, telerehabilitation meetings of the multidisciplinary rehabilitation team, telemetry, control, home teleconsultation and patient education, remote supervision and in other forms that do not contradict the law in case of technical possibility.
